

## HOWARD'S NEUTERING CLINIC

PRICE LIST AUGUST 2011

VAT included at 20%

All prices are fully inclusive except where stated or where extras are requested.

Stitch removal, if needed, is included and any necessary aftercare.

You will not be charged for any follow-up treatment, but if you leave a problem to become an out-of-hours emergency, you will have to pay an out-of-hours charge.

**Microchipping**, insertion and lifetime registration £18  
Done at time of neutering or with 1st vaccination course. £12.50

### DOGS

Operation prices depend on size. The price may be increased if the dog is unusually difficult to handle. These prices are for dogs expected to be under 40kg, we cannot do giant breeds (includes the largest male rottweilers).

**Bitch spay £120 - £190**

3 months after a 'season' or before the first season

**Male dog castration £90 - £120**

normally 5 months

*Dogs adopted from Rescue Centres within the last 6 months - maximum bitch spay £140, dog castration £95. Adoption papers must be shown.*

**First vaccination course**, 2 injections 2-4 weeks apart £45

Booster vaccination, depending what they have had previously, £25- £30

Kennel Cough vaccination (if done with other vaccs, £20) £23

### CATS

**Spay female,**

**4-5 months £42**

**Over 6 months £46**

**Mid term pregnancy £50**

*Around six months we price by the maturity not by the calendar*

Kittens from 10 weeks old can be neutered before re-homing - discuss with vet.

**First vaccination course** 2 injections 3-4 wks apart.

Flu/enteritis only £38

*More than one cat, each* £35

Booster £20

**Castrate male**

**4-5 months £32**

**Over 6 months £36**

Flu/Enteritis & Leukaemia £55

*More than one cat, each* £50

Booster £30

Blood test FeLV/FIV (rescues only) £25

We can also do minor work at the time of neutering:

removal of hind dew claws, repair of umbilical hernia, £10 - £30

removal of retained baby teeth, flushing tear ducts, etc.

**Collection and return:** dogs under 10kg, cats and other small pets.

Within Norwich outer ring road only, **per trip** £15

*Please arrange this when you book the operation. We cannot promise a precise collection or return time but will usually try to collect before 11am and return before 4.30pm.*

## FERRETS

Males, any time over 4 months old. Females, preferably not till the January following. If a Jill is fully in season she will need an injection to stop it before she can be spayed. She will need to be taken to another vet for this. We can spay if the vulval swelling has only just started.

We do not vasectomise male ferrets.

**Spay female £50**

**Castrate male £42**

## RABBITS

any time over 4 months.

**Spay female £55- £65**

**Castrate male £50- £56**

Vaccination: Myxomatosis, single dose

£17.00

*Two rabbits each*

£16.00

*More than two rabbits, each*

Viral Haemorrhagic Disease (VHD)

Prices as for Myxo

*VHD & Myxo (have to be done 2 weeks apart) £2 reduction per rabbit if paid at the time of the first injection.*

**Spay female £60**

**Castrate male**

**£45**

**RAT castration - discuss with vet**

**£40**

**EUTHANASIA** by appointment at the surgery:

**Dogs, over 10kg, £30- £50** (giant breeds extra)

**Cats, small dogs and small pets £20- £30**

**House call extra, from £35** within Norwich outer ring road. Please ask for price outside that. Evening or weekend visits may be possible, there will be an extra charge.

Please note, this is not an emergency service, visits need to be booked before 10am.

*If the animal is currently under treatment by a veterinary practice we would normally speak to them first. We reserve the right to refuse to put an animal to sleep when we cannot consider it justified.*

**Cremation**, or arranging separate cremation,

**Cats & small pets £15.**

**Dogs £20- £40.** Up to 40 kg only.

We can only take large dogs from the house with adequate assistance.

*Separate cremation & return of ashes will be charged for by the crematorium*

**Parasite treatment** Supplied only at the time of other treatment. See drug price list

## OTHER SERVICES

For this work the animals need to be under 12 yo and in good health, and not under treatment by another veterinary surgeon. Animals over 8 yo will need to be checked first - fee will be deducted from operation price.

## PetCheck Clinic

by appointment only

We offer a check-up and advice service for all pet species (mammals and small birds) at a set price **£12.50**

**This is not for treatment of sick or injured animals, nor for animals under treatment by another vet.**

It is a basic clinical examination by the veterinary surgeon, no laboratory tests will be done.

We will

- Check the animal's weight and general health,
- Examine lumps and advise whether they need treatment
- Check teeth and claws
- Examine old animals for any problems which should be treated
- Advise on diet and welfare issues

*We do not do treatments other than those on this price list, if anything is needed you will be advised to go to another veterinary practice.*

We can also do:

**Claw clipping** (beak trimming) and **anal sac emptying** £5 - £15

These can be done by appointment at other times or on house calls

**Housecall prices** - from £35 Budgie beak & claw clipping would be included in the visit charge.
